



AWAC Call for Co-Authors of Statement on A.I. and Writing Across the Curriculum

The Association for Writing Across the Curriculum (AWAC) seeks colleagues to join an ad-hoc committee of co-authors for an expanded AWAC statement on generative A.I. and Writing Across the Curriculum.

In January 2023, AWAC was among the first professional organizations to produce a [statement regarding the role of artificial intelligence in writing classrooms](#) and its potential impact on writing to learn and learning to write. Since 2023, A.I. technologies have continued to advance, student uptake of A.I. has changed, and our understanding as faculty of our role in our classrooms has grown. In fact, preliminary findings from AWAC's *The State of WAC: Issues and Energies* survey suggest that nearly all WAC Directors have created faculty development workshops pertaining to generative A.I., and 89% of participants share that it is highly important to increase their understanding of A.I. and writing to do their WAC job well.

Recognizing that expertise on such matters is inter-disciplinary and expansive, we invite volunteers to help co-author an expanded AWAC statement about A.I. and WAC. Specifically, we seek colleagues who would be interested in lending their knowledge and expertise to help co-author one of the following sections of the expanded statement:

1. *A.I. and Learning Change*: How is A.I. changing writing in the disciplines? How does A.I. inform and counter the thinking process?
2. *Critical A.I. Literacy Across the Curriculum*: What new knowledge and writing strategies
3. *Academic Integrity and A.I.*: Parsing out the problematic relationships between A.I. and accusations of plagiarism, kinds of A.I. use, and more.
4. *A Spectrum of A.I. Applications*: Delineating Uses and Misuse(s)

Co-authors would serve as members of the ad-hoc AWAC committee on A.I. and meet with co-authors as needed. The report will be published on the AWAC website with co-authors recognized.
